Steve's demonstration was full of great information see below for a sampling- (color, color everywhere)

Demo pointers -

Water based dyes raise the grain - & dry slow

Alcohol based dyes do not raise grain – dry quicker – requires no dilution

Best to use foam 'brushes' for applications

Start with darker colors first – then go to the lighter colors

Steve's sequence example:

Sand up to 400 grit—apply Red dye

Sand to 400—apply Yellow dye

Sand to 400 then steel wool

Finish (Poly or Lacquer)

Then Beall's buffing – rouge then tripoli (no white diamond on dark woods) Then wax

Another color sequence – blue – red – yellow (sanding in-between of course) Note Sherwin William's Cab Lacquer is great stuff! - Steve buys it by the gallon.




